MESSAGE FROM TIM BURGESS



We are now at the beginning of 2022, currently experiencing what we hope to be the final wave of the battle with Covid 19.

Local 104, the developers and other supporters of the NECEC project worked tirelessly for 2 ½ years and were ultimately successful in obtaining all the required permits for NECEC. Construction began January 14, 2021.

Then, as many of you may be aware of, on November 2, 2021, a group of supposed environmentalist, who ironically teamed up with fossil fuel generation corporations, were successful in getting enough yes votes using the Maine

people's referendum to temporarily shut down the NECEC project.

The Maine people's referendum has been part of Maine law for 114 years and has never been used to retroactively revoke legally obtained construction permits.

This use of the referendum process will be challenged in court as being unconstitutional. At the time of this writing that exact date has yet TBD.

We are being hopeful that common sense prevails in the courts and that the project will be restarted asap.

As always, Union meetings are held every 3rd Thursday and the winter Certs schedule is available on the website, with classes available in January, February and March.
